1. All operations under this STA are on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis.
2. Operations are limited to the following frequency bands

3. LSB Broadcasting, Inc is not authorized to transmit on the earth station while in motion.
4. LSB Broadcasting, Inc must take all reasonable and customary measures to ensure that the earth station(s) do(es) not create a potential for harmful non-ionizing radiation to persons who may be in the vicinity of the earth station when it is in operation. At a minimum, permanent warning labels shall be fixed to the earth station and its housing warning of the radiation hazard and including a diagram showing the regions around the earth station where radiation levels could exceed 1.0mW/cm². The earth station operator shall be responsible for assuring that individuals do not stray into the regions around the earth station where there is a potential for exceeding the maximum permissible exposure limits required by 47 C.F.R. § 1.1310.
5. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special authority is solely at LSB Broadcasting, Inc's own risk.
6. The grant of the verbal STA request was issued in accordance with emergency procedures put in place to provide communications in areas affected by Hurricane Harvey.
7. This STA may be terminated at the International Bureau's discretion, without a hearing, if conditions warrant. Under no circumstances may the facility(ies) authorized violate the terms of an international agreement or treaty. If an application for permanent authority is on file with the Commission, this action is taken without prejudice to that application. The applicant is required to post and/or retain a copy of this authorization as required by the Commission's Rules.
8. This grant is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective immediately.

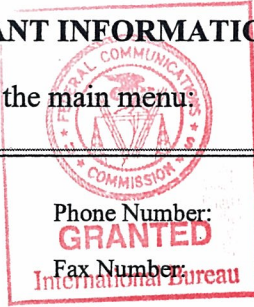

Request for STA

This application seeks Special Temporary Authority to operate a new satellite news gathering (SNG), Domestic Satellite Temporary Fixed (Transportable) Earth Station that will be used in conjunction with commercial TV Station KBMT, Beaumont, Texas. There is currently a Warning for Hurricane Harvey in the area. At the time the Warning was issued, the station took possession of the truck and its engineering consultants are in the process of preparing full technical information for an application to license the station's newly-acquired SNG facilities, to be filed in the ordinary course in the coming weeks. The weather emergency, however, has created an urgent need for the SNG facility to be put into use prior to the completion of the license application. Accordingly, immediate grant of the requested STA would serve the public interest by enhancing the station's coverage of the weather emergency for the people of Beaumont and the surrounding area.
