Special Temporary Authority

- 4. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority is solely 'at Alaska Communications Internet, LLC's risk.
- 5. Grant of this authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future Alaska Communications Internet, LLC's applications.
- 6. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority is solely at Alaska Communications Internet, LLC's risk.
