SES Americom, Inc. is granted a special temporary authority under the following conditions, for 30 days, beginning December 05, 2017, to permit its C-band earth station (E000313) located in Haleiwa, Hawaii, to perform telemetry, tracking and command (TT&C) for the AMC-18 (S2713) satellite during its relocation from 104.95 deg. W.L. to 139 deg. W.L. and once the satellite arrives on-station at 139 deg. W.L., using the following frequency bands: 3700.50 MHz and 4199.50 MHz (space-to-Earth) and 6423.50 (Earth-to-space). At this location, AMC-18 (S2713) satellite will be replaced by the C-band payload of the SES-11 (S2964) satellite, which was launched on October 11, 2017.

1. All operations must be within the coordinated emission and power limits.
2. During the drift to the satellite's permanent orbital location 104.95° W.L., SES Americom, Inc., will coordinate with operators of co-frequency satellites in the drift path.
