("HPT") filed the above-captioned request for 30-day special temporary authorization ("STA"), commencing December 15, 2017, to operate a 9.2m fixed gateway earth station at its facility in Kapolei, Hawaii in the 29.1-29.15 GHz band (Earth-to-space) to communicate with the EUTELSAT 172B satellite at 172° E.L.
