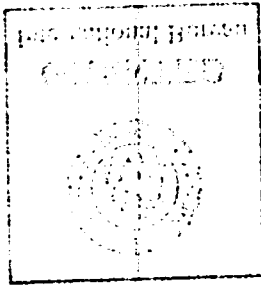

Special Temporary Authority

Enterprise Products Operating, LLC is granted special temporary authority for 60 days, beginning on January 31, 2018, to operate a 2.4 meter earth station antenna at 29° 32' 13' N, 98° 29' 27' W in San Antonio, Texas site, using emission designator 5M00G1W in the 14.00-14.50 GHz (Earth-to-space) and 11.70-12.20 GHz (space-to-Earth) frequency bands to communicate with AMC-21 satellite at 125° W.L., under the following conditions:

1. Operations under this authority are on a non-interference basis only.
2. Operations under this authority are on a non-protected basis only.
3. All operations under this grant of special temporary authority shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis. Enterprise Products Operating, LLC's (E180001), shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating radio communication system.
4. In the event of any harmful interference under this grant of special temporary authority, Enterprise Products Operating, LLC's (E180001), must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.
5. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority is solely 'at Enterprise Products Operating, LLC's risk.
6. Grant of this authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending applications or future requests for special temporary authority. E.g. IBFS File No. SES-LIC-20180104-00004
