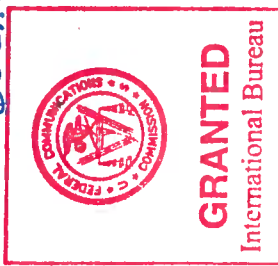

Intelsat License LLC- ("Intelsat") is granted a special temporary authority for 60 days, starting April 26, 2019, to operate its earth station in Castle Rock, Colorado to provide telemetry, tracking, and command ("TT&C") for Intelsat 16 (S2750) on-station at 76.2° W.L. orbital location. Operations shall utilize frequencies 13.9975 GHz, & 14.4995 GHz (Earth-to-space) and 12.19825 GHz, and 12.19875 GHz (space-to-Earth) to assist in response to the damage caused by Hurricane Maria to the communications network in Puerto Rico under the following conditions:

1. Operations will not exceed the operational power levels and parameters coordinated.
2. All operations under this grant of special temporary authority shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis. Intelsat shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating radio communication system.
3. In the event of any harmful interference under this grant of special temporary authority, Intelsat must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.
4. All operators of satellites will be provided with an emergency phone number where the licensee can be reached in the event that harmful interference occurs, Currently the 24x7 contact information for Intelsat satellite is Ph.: (703) -559-7701-East Coast operations Center (primary) – (310)525-5591-West Coast Operations Center (back-up). Requests to speak with Harry Burnham or Kevin Bell.
5. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority is solely at Intelsat's risk.
6. Grant of this authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future Intelsat applications.
7. Operations during the period February 03, 2019 to the date of this grant were authorized pursuant to Section 1.62 of the Commission's rules 47 C.F.R. § 1.62.

This action is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. §0.261, and is effective immediately.

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Intelsat License LLC (“Intelsat”) herein requests an additional 60 days of Special Temporary Authority (“STA”)¹ previously granted Intelsat, to use its Castle Rock, Colorado Ku-band earth station (Call Sign KL92) to provide telemetry, tracking, and command (“TT&C”) services² for Intelsat 16 (S2750) on-station at 76.2° W.L.³ Intelsat seeks this STA further extension in order to continue assisting a customer in responding to the damage caused by Hurricane Maria to the communications networks in Puerto Rico while its application for authorization to operate this antenna on a permanent basis is pending before the Commission.⁴

TT&C operations will continue to be performed in the following frequencies: 12198.25 MHz, 12198.75 MHz, 13997.5 MHz, and 14499.5 MHz. The TT&C operations at 76.2° W.L. will continue to be consistent with Intelsat’s coordination agreements for the nominal 76.2° W.L. orbital location. In further support of this request, Intelsat incorporates by reference Exhibit A submitted with its original STA request,⁵ which contains technical information that demonstrates that the operation of the earth station will be compatible with its electromagnetic environment and will not cause harmful

interference into any lawfully operating terrestrial facility or into Federal systems operating in the 13.75-14.00 GHz band. In the extremely unlikely event that harmful interference should occur due to transmissions to or from its earth station, Intelsat will take all reasonable steps to eliminate the interference.

Grant of this STA further extension request will allow Intelsat to continue assisting a customer in providing critical communication services in Puerto Rico. Accordingly, grant of this STA further extension request is in the public interest.
