Dear Ms. Dortch:

AC BidCo LLC ("AC BidCo"), by its attorney and pursuant to Section 1.65 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.65, hereby updates the above-referenced request seeking special temporary authority to add three satellites including Amazonas-2 as points of communication for AC BidCo's earth station aboard aircraft ("ESAA") network (the "STA Request") to advise the Commission of a change in the teleport proposed to be used with Amazonas-2.

In the STA Request, AC BidCo stated that because the teleport it planned to use with Amazonas-2, E891020, did not yet have Ku-band authority, AC BidCo intended to temporarily use a different teleport. Subsequent to the filing of the STA Request, however, the Commission granted STA for E891020 allowing Ku-band operations.¹ Accordingly, AC BidCo updates the STA Request to specify use of E891020 as the teleport for ESAA operations with Amazonas-2.

AC BidCo requests that the Commission take this update into account in processing the STA Request. Please let me know if you have any questions regarding this matter.
