Alascom, Inc. is granted a special temporary authority for 30 days, beginning October 03, 2019, to utilize its Anchorage, Alaska earth station to backup telecommunication services to communities with Spaceway1(S2191) satellite while using the following frequencies: 29500-30000 MHz (Earth-to-space) and 19700-20200 MHz (space-to-Earth) under the following conditions:

1. Operations will not exceed the operational power levels and parameters.
2. All operations under this grant of special temporary authority shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis. Alascom, Inc shall not cause harmful interference to and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating radio communication system.
3. In the event of any harmful interference under this grant of special temporary authority, Alascom, Inc. must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.
4. Per US334 footnote, satellite(s) operating in the bands 17.7-20.2 GHz frequency band must ensure an existing coordination between Federal FSS systems and non-Federal space and terrestrial systems operating in accordance with the United States Table of Frequency Allocations is required
5. All operators of satellites will be provided with an emergency phone number where the licensee can be reached in the event that harmful interference occurs, Currently the 24x7 contact information for Spaceway1 mission is Ph.: (907) 264-7869.- Request to speak with Scott Wood.
6. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority is solely at Alascom, Inc's risk.
7. Grant of this authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future Alascom, Inc's applications.
8. Alascom, Inc operations during the period September 02, 2019 to the date of this grant were authorized pursuant to Section 1.62 of the Commission's rules 47 C.F.R. § 1.62.

This action is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. §0.261, and is effective immediately.

Pursuant to Section 1.62 of the Commission's rules, Alascom, Inc. will continue to operate pursuant to the terms and conditions of its existing STA pending action on this renewal request.
