Special Temporary Authority ("STA")

Intelsat License LLC is granted extension of special temporary authority for 30 days to operate its earth station, Call Sign KA258, in Hagerstown, MD to provide telemetry, tracking, and command (TT&C) services to the HYLAS-1 satellite, licensed by the United Kingdom, during the satellite's drifts to and on-station at 79.0.1° W orbital location with the following center frequencies: 17302.048 MHz (H, LHCP), and 17305.051 MHz (H, RHCP) (Earth-to-space); and 11701.008 MHz (V, LHCP) and 11702.808 MHz (V, RHCP) (space-to-Earth). Operations are authorized under the following conditions:

1. All operations must comply with the limits currently authorized for operations of KA258.
2. All operations under this grant of STA shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis. Intelsat shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference, any other lawfully operating radio communication system.
3. In the event of any harmful interference Intelsat License LLC shall cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and shall immediately inform the Commission, in writing, of such an event.
4. Grant of this STA is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future Intelsat License LLC applications.
5. Any action taken, or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this STA is solely at Intelsat License LLC's risk.
6. Operations of this station during the period from expiration of October 16, 2019, IBFS file number SES-STA-20190827-01127 to the grant of this special temporary authority was authorized pursuant to Section 1.62 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.62.

This grant is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective upon release.

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Intelsat License LLC (“Intelsat”) herein requests an additional 30 days of Special Temporary Authority (“STA”)<sup>1</sup> previously granted to Intelsat<sup>2</sup> to use its Hagerstown, Maryland Ku-band earth station (Call Sign KA258) to provide telemetry, tracking, and command (“TT&C”) services for HYLAS-1<sup>3</sup> during the satellite’s drift to and on-station at 79.0° W.L. Intelsat will provide TT&C services for approximately five months.

HYLAS-1 TT&C operations are being performed in the following frequencies:

- 17302.048 MHz (H, LHCP), and 17305.051 MHz (H, RHCP) in the uplink; and
- 11701.008 MHz (V, LHCP) and 11702.808 MHz (V, RHCP) in the downlink.

The drift operations will continue to be coordinated with all operators of satellites that use the same frequency bands and are in the drift path.<sup>4</sup> All operators of satellites in that path have been provided with an emergency phone number where the licensee can be reached in the event that harmful

interference occurs. In the extremely unlikely event that harmful interference should occur due to transmissions to or from its earth station, Intelsat will take all reasonable steps to eliminate the interference.
