DIRECTV Enterprises, LCC ("DIRECTV") - is granted a special temporary authority for 30 days, beginning November 20, 2019, to utilize its Bakersfield, CA earth station to deorbit its T4S (S2430) satellite at the nominal 101° W.L. orbital location using the following frequencies, 17300.0 - 17800.0 MHz (Left and Right Circular) (Earth-to-space) and 12200.0-12700.00 MHz (Left and Right Circular) (space-to-Earth) under the following conditions:

1. All operations may not exceed off axis eirp limits established in §25.218.
2. All operations under this grant of special temporary authority shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis. DIRECTV shall not cause harmful interference to and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating radio communication system.
3. In the event of any harmful interference under this grant of special temporary authority, DIRECTV must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.
4. All operators of satellites will be provided with an emergency phone number where the licensee can be reached in the event that harmful interference occurs, Currently the 24x7 contact information for the DIRECTV mission is as follows: Ph.: (310) 429-1624- Request to speak with Steve Dulac.
5. Grant of this authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future DIRECTV applications.
6. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority is solely at DIRECTV's risk.
7. Operations of this station during the period from expiration of November 14, 2019, to the grant of this special temporary authority was authorized pursuant to Section 1.62 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §1.62.

This action is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. §0.261, and is effective immediately.

REQUEST FOR SPECIAL TEMPORARY AUTHORITY

DIRECTV Enterprises, LLC (“DIRECTV”) respectfully requests an extension of its grant of earth station special temporary authority (“STA”) for an additional 30 days to operate its Bakersfield, California earth station (Call Sign E170103) to deorbit DIRECTV’s T4S satellite (Call Sign S2430). Pursuant to Section 1.62 of the Commission’s rules,¹ DIRECTV will continue to operate pursuant to the terms and conditions of its existing STA² pending action on this timely filed renewal request.

T4S is approaching the end of its operational life, and DIRECTV began deorbiting the satellite on September 25, 2019. On September 3, 2019, the Commission granted DIRECTV special temporary authority to operate its Bakersfield, California earth station (Call Sign E170103) to deorbit T4S utilizing a satellite arc east limit of 55.0° W.L. (with elevation of 12.5° and azimuth of 105.7°) and a satellite arc west limit of 170.0° W.L. (with elevation of 23.0° and azimuth of 244.9°) for all of the earth station’s authorized frequency ranges.³ By this application, DIRECTV respectfully requests an extension of its current grant of STA for an additional 30 days to allow sufficient time to complete the deorbiting process.
