Special Temporary Authority

Intelsat License LLC, as debtor-in-possession (“Intelsat”) is granted extension of special temporary authority for 30 days to continue to operate its Hagerstown, MD earth station, call sign KA258, to provide telemetry, tracking, and command (TT&C) services to the HYLAS-1, UK licensed satellite, as it drifts to the 79.0° W.L on the following center frequencies: 17302.048 MHz (H, LHCP), and 17305.051 MHz (H, RHCP) (Earth-to-space); and 11701.008 MHz (V, LHCP) and 11702.808 MHz (V, RHCP) (space-to-Earth). Operations are authorized under the following conditions:

1. All operations must comply with the limits currently authorized for operations of KA258.
2. All operations under this grant of STA shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis. Intelsat shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference, any other lawfully operating radio communication system.
3. In the event of any harmful interference Intelsat shall cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and shall immediately inform the Commission, in writing, of such an event.
4. Grant of this STA is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future Intelsat applications.
5. Any action taken, or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this STA is solely at Intelsat's risk.
6. Operations of this station during the period from expiration of October 16, 2019, FCC IBFS File No. SES-STA-20190827-01127, to the grant of this STA was authorized pursuant to Section 1.62 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.62.

This grant is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective upon release.
