Special Temporary Authority (STA)

DIRECTV Enterprises, LLC is granted special temporary authority for 30 days commencing January 22, 2020 to operate its Long Beach, CA earth station to deorbit its SPACEWAY 1 satellite (S2191). DIRECTV is authorized to operate this earth station utilizing a satellite arc east limit of 55.0° W.L. (with elevation of 13.5° and azimuth of 105.7°) and a satellite arc west limit of 160.0° W.L. (with elevation of 30.8° and azimuth of 238.1°) in all currently authorized frequency ranges under the following conditions:

1. All operations under this grant of STA shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis. DIRECTV shall not cause harmful interference to and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating radio communication system.
2. In the event of any harmful interference as a result of operations under this grant of special temporary authority, DIRECTV shall cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference and shall immediately inform the Commission, in writing, of such an event.
3. Grant of this STA is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future DIRECTV applications.
4. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this STA is solely at DIRECTV's risk.

This grant is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective upon release.
