Special Temporary Authority

Intelsat License LLC - as debtor-in-position ("Intelsat") is granted a Special Temporary Authority for 30 days beginning December 04, 2020 to use its Fillmore, California C-band earth station to provide launch and early orbit phase ("LEOP") services for the GSAT-12R (CMS 01) satellite on the following center frequencies: 6415.000 MHz and 6421.480 MHz (Earth-to-space), and 4186.320 MHz and 4191.840 MHz (space-to-Earth) under the following conditions:

1. Operations will not exceed the operational power levels and parameters.
2. All operations under this grant of special temporary authority shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis. Intelsat shall not cause harmful interference to and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating radio communication system.
3. In the event of any harmful interference under this grant of special temporary authority. Intelsat must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.
4. All operators of satellites will be provided with an emergency phone number where the licensee can be reached in the event that harmful interference occurs, Currently the 24x7 contact information for GSAT-12R (CMS 01) LEOP mission is Ph.: (703) 559-7701 -East Coast Operations Center (primary); (310) 525-5591-West Coast Operations Center (back-up). 5. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority is solely at Intelsat's risk.
6. Grant of this authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future Intelsat applications.

This action is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. §0.261, and is effective immediately.
