Special Temporary Authority (“STA”)

Intelsat License LLC, as debtor-in-possession (“Intelsat”) is granted extension of STA for 30 days to continue to operate at its fixed earth station in Castle Rock, CO to provide back-up telemetry, tracking, and command (“TT&C”) services for HYLAS-1 satellite on-station at orbital location 79.0°W on center frequencies 17302.048 MHz (H,LHCP) and 17305.051 MHz (H, RHCP) (Earth-to-space); and 11701.008 MHz (V, LHCP) and 11702.808 MHz (V, RHCP) (space-to-Earth) under the following conditions:

1. All operations under this grant of extension of STA shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis. Intelsat shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating radio communication system.
2. In the event of any harmful interference as a result of operations under this grant of extension of STA shall cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference and shall immediately inform the Commission, in writing, of such an event.

4. Grant of this STA is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future Intelsat applications.
5. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this STA is solely at Intelsat’s risk.
6. Operations under STA during the period from expiration of March 24, 2020, FCC IBFS File Nos. SES-STA-20200106-00014 and SES-STA-20200217-001761 to the grant of this STA was authorized pursuant to Section 1.62 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.62.

This grant is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission’s rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective upon release.
