Special Temporary Authority (“STA”)

Televiscentro of Puerto Rico, LLC (“Televiscentro of Puerto Rico”) is granted to operate for 60 days, commencing July 29, 2020, under Special Temporary Authority to use its existing 4.9-m Temporary-Fixed earth station antenna located in San Juan, Puerto Rico with the Galaxy 16 satellite (Call Sign S2687) at orbital location 99°W in the 5925-6078.35 MHz and 6307-6425 MHz (Earth-to-space), and 3700-4200 MHz (space-to-Earth) frequency bands under the following conditions:

1. Operations must comply with the operational parameters listed in the pending application SES- MOD-20200612-00615.
2. Operations, shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from, interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference and notify the FCC in writing.
3. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this STA is solely at Televiscentro of Puerto Rico’s risk.
4. The licensee shall, at all times, take all necessary measures to ensure that operation of this (these) authorized earth station(s) does not create potential exposure of humans to radiofrequency radiation in excess of the FCC exposure limits defined in 47 CFR §§ 1.1307(b) and 1.1310. Physical measures must be taken to ensure compliance with limits for both occupational/controlled exposure and for general population/uncontrolled exposure, as defined in these rule sections. Compliance can be accomplished in most cases by appropriate restrictions, such as fencing. Requirements for restrictions can be determined by predictions based on calculations, modeling, or by field measurements. The FCC’s OET Bulletin 65 (available on-line at www.fcc.gov/oet/rfsafety) provides information on predicting exposure levels and on methods for ensuring compliance, including the use of warning and alerting signs and protective equipment for workers.
5. Grant of this STA is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding Televiscentro of Puerto Rico’s pending application SES- MOD-20200612-00615.

This action is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission’s rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective immediately.
