Special Temporary Authority ("STA")

Intelsat License LLC- as debtor in possession ("Intelsat") is granted STA for 30 days, starting July 28, 2020 to operate its fixed C-band earth station located at geographic coordinates 39° 35' 54"N, 77° 45' 35"W in Hagerstown, MD to provide launch and early orbit phase ("LEOP") services for the MEV-2 satellite (Call Sign S3059) which is expected to launch on July 28, using frequencies 5924.0 MHz, 5925.2 MHz, 6170.0 MHz, 6180.0 MHz, and 6424.0 MHz (Earth-to-space); and 3701.0 MHz, 3944.5 MHz, 3955.5 MHz, and 4199.8 MHz (space-to-Earth). MEV-2 satellite will be at the 1.0° W.L orbital location operating under the following conditions:

1. Operations, shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from, interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference.
2. In the event of any harmful interference under this grant of STA, Intelsat must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.
3. The IOT operations must be coordinated with all operators of satellites that use the same frequency bands and location. All operators of satellites in that path will be provided with an emergency phone number where the licensee can be reached in the event that harmful interference occurs. 4. Grant of this authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future Intelsat applications.
5. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this STA is solely at Intelsat's risk.

This action is issued pursuant to Section 0.26 1 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. §0.26 1, and is effective immediately.
