GUSA Licensee LLC (together with its parent Globalstar, Inc., (“Globalstar”)) is granted (60-days) special temporary authorization (“STA”) starting June 16, 2021 to operate a second-generation feeder link antenna at Globalstar’s new gateway earth station facility in Clifton, TX with Globalstar (S2115) using frequency bands 5091 – 5250 MHz (Earth-to-space) and 6875 – 7055 MHz (space-to-Earth)) to test and validate waveforms under the following conditions: .

1. Operations will not exceed operational power levels and parameters 68.4 Max EIRP (dBW) and 51 Max Eirp Density (dBW/4kHz).
2. Operations, shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from, interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference.
3. In the event of any harmful interference, Globalstar shall cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and shall immediately inform the Commission, in writing, of such an event.
4. Army Spectrum Office/ and Army Area frequency area offices are kept aware of any changes to the requested schedule of operations:

6. Grant of this STA is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future Globalstar applications.
7. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this STA is solely at Globalstar’s risk.
8. Operations during the period November 09, 2020 to the date of this grant are authorized pursuant to Section 1.62 of the Commission's rules 47 C.F. R. § 1.62.

This grant is issued pursuant to Section 0.26 1 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective upon release.
