Dear Ms. Dortch:

Intelsat License LLC, as debtor in possession ("Intelsat"), herein requests 60 days of Special Temporary Authority ("STA")¹ commencing January 13, 2021, to use its Hagerstown, Maryland Ku-band earth station, Call Sign E060029, to communicate with the SES-4 satellite (S2828)² on-station at 22.0° W.L. In support of the proposed operations, Intelsat will also be filing an application to permanently modify the E060029 earth station license.

The proposed communication services will be performed in the following frequencies: 14000-14500 MHz in the uplink and 11700-12200 MHz in the downlink.
