Special Temporary Authority

Intelsat License LLC, as debtor-in-possession (“Intelsat”) is granted extension of Special Temporary Authority for 30 days to operate its fixed satellite earth station located at geographic coordinates 33° 47’45.1” N/117° 05’16.3” W in Nuevo, CA to provide telemetry, tracking, and command (“TT&C”) services for Galaxy 30 (S3016) satellite at the 125°W orbital location on center frequencies: 6421.75 MHz and 6424.25 MHz (Earth-to-space) and 4197.5 MHz and 4198.5 MHz (space-to-Earth), under the following conditions:

1. All operations shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis, Intelsat, E040125, shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from, interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.
2. All operators of adjacent satellites must be provided with an emergency phone number where the licensee can be reached when harmful interference occurs. Currently the 24x7 contact information for the Galaxy 30 mission is as follows: Ph.: (703) 559-7701 - East Coast Operations Center (primary); (310) 525-5591 - West Coast Operations Center (back-up). 3. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this STA is solely at Intelsat’s risk.
4. Operations of this station during the period from expiration of January 19, 2021, FCC IBFS file number SES-STA-20201209-01316 to the grant of this Special Temporary Authority was authorized pursuant to Section 1.62 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.62.

This action is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission’s rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. §0.261, and is effective upon release.
