Special Temporary Authority (“STA”)

Intelsat is granted special temporary authority for 60 days beginning January 25, 2021 to perform antenna test verification of its Brewster, WA C-band earth station (Call Sign E202208) with the Galaxy 3C (S2381), Galaxy 12 (S2422), Galaxy 13 (S2386), Galaxy 14 (S2385), Galaxy 15 (S2387), Galaxy 16 (S2687), Galaxy 17 (S2715), Galaxy 18 (S2733), Galaxy 19 (S2647), Galaxy 23 (S2592), Galaxy 25 (S2154), Galaxy 28 (S2160), Galaxy 30 (S3016), Horizons 1 (S2475), Intelsat 18 (S2817), Intelsat 23 (S2831), and Intelsat 34 (S2915) satellites in the 3625-4200 MHz (space-to-Earth) and 5850-6425 MHz (Earth-to-space) frequency bands. under the following conditions:

1. Operations, shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from, interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference.
2. In the event of any harmful interference under this grant of STA, Intelsat License LLC must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.
3. Grant of this authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future Intelsat License LLC applications.
6. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this STA is solely at Intelsat License LLC’s risk.

This action is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission’s rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. §0.261, and is effective immediately. The grant of this STA is authorized pursuant to Section 1.62 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.62.
