Univision Network Limited Partnership is granted special temporary authority beginning May 31, 2021 for 180 days to operate its 4.5 meter antenna associated with E900570 at its Miami, FL Doral campus site with the SES-3 satellite at the 103.0° W orbital location while it completes the equipment upgrade of its 9.1 meter primary SES-3 uplink antenna at the same location pursuant to the C-band transition plan for SES-3. Operations will be conducted on center frequencies 4020 MHz (space-to Earth) and 6245 MHz (Earth to space) at 350 watts at the flange.

- 1. Operations will not exceed the operational power limits and parameters requested and coordinated.
- 2. All operations under this grant of STA shall be on an unprotected, non-harmful interference basis.
- 3. In the event of any harmful interference Univision shall cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and shall immediately inform the Commission, in writing, of such an event.
- 4. The licensee shall take all necessary measures to ensure that the antenna does not create potential exposure of humans to radiofrequency radiation in excess of the FCC exposure limits defined in 47 CFR 1.1307(b) and 1.1310 wherever such exposures might occur. Measures must be taken to ensure compliance with limits for both occupational/controlled exposure and for general population/uncontrolled exposure, as defined in these rule sections. The FCC's OET Bulletin 65 (available on-line at www.fcc.gov/oet/rfsafety) provides information on predicting exposure levels and on methods for ensuring compliance, including the use of warning and alert signs and protective equipment for workers.
- 5. Grant of this STA is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding Univision pending applications.
- 6. Any action taken, or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this STA is solely at Univision's risk.

This grant is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 CFR § 0.261, and is effective upon release. This special temporary authority was authorized pursuant to Section 1.62 of the Commission's rules, 47 CFR § 1.62.
