Special Temporary Authority

GCI Communication Corp. (“GCI”) is granted a special temporary authority for 60 days commencing September 16, 2021 to operate its 3.8 meter GD Satcom 2385 antenna fixed satellite service (“FSS”) earth station in Kobuk, Alaska to communicate with the Eutelsat 115 West B satellite (S2938) at 114.9 W.L. at 5.925-6.425 GHz (Earth-to-space) and 3.7-4.2 GHz (space-to-Earth) under the following conditions:

1. All operations under this grant of special temporary authority shall be on an unprotected and non-harmful interference basis. GCI Communication Corp. (“GCI”) shall not cause harmful interference to and shall not claim protection from interference caused to it by, any other lawfully operating radio communication system.
2. In the event of any harmful interference under this grant of special temporary authority, GCI Communication Corp. (“GCI”) must cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and must inform the Commission, in writing, immediately of such an event.
3. All operators of satellites will be provided with an emergency phone number where the licensee can be reached in the event that harmful interference occurs, Currently the 24x7 contact information for the Technical Assistance Center is Ph.: 800-770-8725.
4. Any action taken or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this special temporary authority is solely at GCI Communication Corp. (“GCI”).
5. Grant of this authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future GCI Communication Corp. (“GCI”)’s applications.

This action is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on authority, 47 C.F.R. §0.261, and is effective immediately.
