Special Temporary Authority ("STA")

Intelsat License LLC is granted to operate its fixed earth station located at geographical coordinates 33°47'47"N / 117°5'19"W in Riverside, Nuevo CA under STA for 30 days, commencing November 12, 2021, to provide operations on Galaxy 30 (S3016) at 125.0° W.L on frequency bands: 29525-29975 MHz (Earth-to-space), 18325-18775 MHz (space-to-Earth) under the following conditions:

1. Operations shall be with the earth station's authorized emission designation to conduct transmissions and shall not exceed corresponding authorized power.
2. All operations under this grant of STA shall be on an unprotected and nonharmful interference basis. Intelsat shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from interference, any other lawfully operating radio communication system.
3. In the event of any harmful interference Intelsat License LLC shall cease operations immediately upon notification of such interference, and shall immediately inform the Commission, in writing, of such an event.
4. Grant of this STA is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future Intelsat License LLC applications.
5. Intelsat License LLC shall, at all times, take all necessary measures to ensure that the STA operation at this earth station does not create potential exposure of humans to radiofrequency radiation in excess of the FCC exposure limits defined in 47 CFR § 1.1307(b) and 1.1310. Physical measures must be taken to ensure compliance with limits for both occupational/controlled exposure and for general population/uncontrolled exposure, as defined in these rule sections. Compliance can be accomplished in most cases by appropriate restrictions, such as fencing. Requirements for restrictions can be determined by predictions based on calculations, modeling, or by field measurements. The FCC's OET Bulletin 65 (available on-line at [ww.fcc.gov/oet/safety](http://www.fcc.gov/oet/safety)) provides information on predicting exposure levels and on methods for ensuring compliance, including the use of warning and alerting signs and protective equipment for workers.
6. Any action taken, or expense incurred as a result of operations pursuant to this STA is solely at Intelsat License LLC 's risk.
7. Operations since the expiration of the previous STA and Nov 12, 2021 were authorized as continuing operations under Section 1.62.

This grant is issued pursuant to Section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 C.F.R. § 0.261, and is effective upon release.
