Dear Ms. Dortch:

Intelsat License LLC ("Intelsat") herein requests 30 days of Special Temporary Authority ("STA"),¹ commencing March 27, 2023, to operate its Nuevo, California Ka-band earth station, Call Sign E210042, to communicate with the Galaxy 30 (S3016) satellite for antenna verification testing prior to the antenna's use. Intelsat has filed for authority to operate this antenna on a permanent basis.²

The proposed testing will be performed at 20060 MHz (downlink) and 28460 MHz (uplink). The operations will be consistent with Intelsat's relevant coordination agreements.

Operation of the earth station will be compatible with its electromagnetic environment and will not cause harmful interference into any lawfully operating terrestrial facility. In the extremely unlikely event that harmful interference should occur due to transmissions to or from its earth station, Intelsat will take all reasonable steps to eliminate the interference.

Grant of this STA request will allow Intelsat to ensure the antenna's performance prior to providing customer services and thereby promotes the public interest. For the reasons set forth herein, Intelsat respectfully requests that the Commission grant this STA request.
