Re: Request for Special Temporary Authority to Drift Galaxy 12 to 137.1° W.L.
Call Sign E202210; Brewster, Washington

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Intelsat License LLC ("Intelsat") herein requests 30 days of Special Temporary Authority ("STA"),¹ commencing May 15, 2023, to use its Brewster, Washington C-band earth station, Call Sign E202210, to provide telemetry, tracking, and command ("TT&C") services for Galaxy 12 (Call Sign S2422) during the satellite's drift from 129.0° W.L. to 137.1° W.L.² Galaxy 12 is expected to start drifting on May 15, 2023.³ Intelsat expects the drift to last 40 days.

The Galaxy 12 operations will be performed at the following frequencies:
6424.500 MHz (uplink); and
4198.000 MHz and 4199.875 MHz (downlink).

All potentially affected operators will be provided with an emergency phone number where the licensee can be reached in the event that harmful interference occurs. In the extremely unlikely event that harmful interference should occur due to transmissions to or from its earth station, Intelsat will take all reasonable steps to eliminate the interference.

Grant of this STA request will allow Intelsat to safely drift Galaxy 12 to its new location. This, in turn, will help provide services at the 137.1° W.L. location and thereby promotes the public interest.
