Re: Request for Further Extension of Special Temporary Authority to Operate Ku-band Flat Panel Antenna

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Intelsat License LLC ("Intelsat") herein requests an additional 30 days of Special Temporary Authority ("STA")¹ previously granted to Intelsat to operate a Ball 6x6 0.46m Ku-band flat-panel antenna for drive tests in McLean, Virginia; Mt. Prospect, Illinois; and from McLean, Virginia to Florida.² Intelsat expects drive tests to continue through May 2023.

Pursuant to grant, operations will continue in the following frequency bands: 11700-12200 MHz (downlink) and 14000-14500 MHz (uplink) with Galaxy 11, Galaxy 18, SKY-B1, Intelsat 37e, and OneWeb's non-geostationary orbit constellation.³ In support of this request, Intelsat incorporates by reference additional operational information, the map of the Virginia-Florida route, and the Radiation Hazard Report included with its original request.⁴

In the extremely unlikely event that harmful interference should occur due to transmissions to or from its antenna, Intelsat will take all reasonable steps to eliminate the interference.
