

Request to Extend Special Temporary Authority

Myriota Pty. Ltd. (“Myriota”), pursuant to Section 25.120 of the Commission’s rules, hereby respectfully requests a 30-day extension of its existing special temporary authority (“STA”)¹ to operate its customer earth stations consistent with the parameters articulated in its underlying Myriota earth station application (“MES Application”).² Myriota seeks temporary authority to continue integration and testing operations for its customer earth stations prior to commercial service. Myriota seeks authority to continue to operate these earth stations for a 30-day period starting on June 10, 2023.

Myriota has been operating under its initial STA without incident. Grant of this application is in the public interest as it will enable Myriota’s customers to integrate and test Myriota’s earth stations prior to the initiation of commercial service. This will facilitate the quick and timely delivery of service once the MES Application is granted.

Myriota will continue to operate on a non-interference basis. Consistent with its MES application and previous STA, Myriota will continue to operate consistent with its previous technical showings and in accordance with its prior coordination with the U.S. Government.³ However, in the unlikely event that harmful interference should occur due to transmissions to or from its spacecraft, Myriota will take all reasonable steps to eliminate the interference.

For the foregoing reasons, the Commission should find that the continued authorization of Myriota’s integration operations would serve the public interest and grant an STA extension for an additional 30 days.
