

REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF SPECIAL TEMPORARY AUTHORITY

BlackSky Global LLC (“BlackSky”), pursuant to Section 25.120 (b)(2) of the Commission’s rules, hereby requests Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) for permission for a period of one-hundred and eighty (180) days to receive signals from its already authorized non-geostationary orbit satellite constellation¹ on additional UHF channels to those UHF channels already authorized for receipt at its Brewster, Washington satellite earth station facility.

The technical specifications for these operations are set forth in Schedule B of BlackSky’s pending application to modify its license to operate the Brewster facility which was filed contemporaneously with its original STA request.² The underlying need and premises for the STA remain the same as stated in BlackSky’s original STA request. Although BlackSky’s initial STA was granted,³ its modification application remains pending.

Accordingly, for good cause shown, BlackSky seeks to extend STA until that modification can be granted.
