Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority
Call Sign: E120106

Intelsat License LLC (“Intelsat”) herein requests an additional 180 days of Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to communicate with the Astra 3B, NSS-12, GSAT-14 and AMOS-17 satellites in International Telecommunication Union Regions 1 and 3,¹ using up to 1,000 units of the AeroSat HR6400 and up to 1,000 units of the ThinKom 2Ku airplane mounted terminals currently licensed under Call Sign E120106.²

Specifically, Intelsat requests STA consistent with the scope of authority previously granted by the Federal Communications Commission,³ as described in the prior grant of authority attached with this application in the International Communications Filing System. This includes a request for extension of all prior-granted waivers.

Grant of this STA extension is in the public interest because it will allow Intelsat to continue using these terminals to provide replacement capacity after the total loss of the Intelsat 33e satellite.
