Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority
Call Sign: E040125; Nuevo, California

Intelsat License LLC (“Intelsat”) herein requests an additional 30 days of Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to use its Nuevo, California C-band earth station, E040125, to provide launch and early orbit phase (“LEOP”) services for the GISAT-1A satellite, licensed by India.¹ Intelsat expects the LEOP period to last approximately one week upon launch of GISAT-1A, which is now projected to be no earlier than May 15, 2026.

Specifically, Intelsat requests STA consistent with the scope of authority previously granted and extended by the Federal Communications Commission,² as described in the prior grant of authority attached with this application in International Communications Filing System.

Grant of this STA extension is in the public interest because it will allow Intelsat to help launch the GISAT-1A satellite, which will provide capacity at the 85.5° E.L. location.
