Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority
Call Sign: KL92; Castle Rock, Colorado

Intelsat License LLC (“Intelsat”) herein requests an additional 30 days of Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to use its Castle Rock, Colorado earth station, KL92, to provide telemetry, tracking, and command (“TT&C”) services for the UK-licensed ViaSat-3 F2 satellite on-station at 79.0° W.L.¹

Specifically, Intelsat requests STA consistent with the scope of authority previously granted and extended by the Federal Communications Commission,² as described in the prior grant of authority attached with this application in the International Communications Filing System.

Grant of this STA extension is in the public interest because it will allow Intelsat to provide on-station TT&C services for the ViaSat-3 F2 satellite at the 79.0° W.L. location.
