Scope of Grant:	Viasat, Inc ("Viasat"), is granted a 60-day special temporary authority (STA), to operate its satellite earth station to communicate with the NGSO MX3 (WP2XYJ) and TAVH (WP2XXL) satellites.	
Service Area(s):	64° 47' 37.0" N, 147° 32' 10.0" W in North Pole, AK	
Frequencies:	Operations will be performed at the following center frequencies: 2080.2 MHz with emission bandwidths of 1.2 MHz, 1.35 MHz, 192 kHz, and 216 kHz (Earth-to-space) 8487 MHz with emission bandwidths of 15.5 MHz (space-to-Earth)	
Operations under this grant must comport with the legal and technical specifications set forth by the applicant or petitioner and with Federal Communication Commission's rules not waived herein. This grant is also subject to the following conditions: 1. STA operations must not exceed the operational power levels and parameters requested and coordinated, and must comport with the technical specifications described in the underlying application, as amended, except as conditioned in this grant of STA. 2. STA operations must use the minimum power level necessary to establish communications links in order to minimize potential interference to licensed users. 3. All operations under this grant of STA must be on an unprotected and non-interference basis (NIB), i.e., Viasat must not cause harmful interference to and must not claim protection from interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station. 4. In the event of any harmful interference caused by operations under this grant of STA, Viasat must immediately cease operations upon notification of such interference. Viasat must immediately inform the Commission, in writing, of such an event. 5. Earth station transmissions in the 2025–2110 MHz band are subject to prior coordination with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers, Inc. (SBE) frequency coordinator. Consult the list at https://sbe.org/resources/frequency-coordination/ to find the appropriate coordinator. 6. Viasat shall ensure that earth station transmissions are ceased when the STPSat-6 (NORAD ID: 49817) spacecraft is within 10 degrees of the earth station antenna boresight. 7. The 24/7 point of contact in the United States, with authority and ability to cease all emissions, for this operation is +1 (720) 493-7300. 8. STA operations must be in compliance with earth station applicable operations allowed by the space station authorization(s) or grant(s), including all relevant conditions, waivers,		

and findings therein.

This grant is issued pursuant to section 0.261 of the Commission's rules on delegated authority, 47 CFR § 0.261, and is effective upon release. This STA is authorized pursuant to the Commission's rule 47 CFR § 25.120.
