Scope of Grant:	Multimedia CTI, S.A. de C.V. ("Mutimedia"), is granted an additional 30-day special temporary authority (STA) to operate its satellite news gathering (SNG) temporary fixed transportable earth station in the vicinity of the 11 stadiums across the U.S. to support the national and international broadcast operations associated with the FIFA World Cup tournament.	
Service Area(s):	In the vicinity of the 11 stadiums across the U.S. (See table in STA conditions)	
Frequencies:	Operations will be performed in the following frequency bands: 5850–6425 MHz (Earth-to-space) 4000–4200 MHz (space-to-Earth)	
Operations under this grant must comport with the legal and technical specifications set forth by the applicant or petitioner and with Federal Communication Commission's rules not waived herein. This grant is also subject to the following conditions: 1. STA operations must not exceed the operational power levels and parameters requested and coordinated. 2. Operations of this STA are authorized only in the vicinity of the 11 stadiums across the U.S. that are listed in the table below:

4. All operations under this grant of STA must be on an unprotected and non-interference basis (NIB), i.e., Mutimedia must not cause harmful interference to and must not claim protection from interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station.
5. In the event of any harmful interference caused by operations under this grant of STA, Mutimedia must immediately cease operations upon notification of such interference. Mutimedia must immediately inform the Commission, in writing, of such an event.

7. STA operations must be in compliance with earth station applicable operations allowed by the space station authorization(s) or grant(s), including all relevant conditions, waivers, and findings therein.
8. STA operations since the expiration of the previous STA and the commencement of this STA were authorized as continuing operations under 47 CFR § 1.62.
