

STA DESCRIPTION

Hubble Network Inc. (“Hubble”) seeks a 60-day extension of the existing 60-day Part 25 special temporary authority (“STA”),¹ from August 10, 2026, to October 9, 2026, for unlimited Part 15-compliant devices to transmit 2482.710675-2483.424 MHz (“2.4 GHz”) signals to the Hubble-1 to 7 satellites.² Background information appears in the corresponding regular authority application that is pending and the granted space station authority applications.³ All corresponding technical parameters remain the same as previously authorized.⁴
