

Maris Developments E181611

Request for 30-day Extension of Special Temporary Authority (“STA”)

Maris Developments (“Maris”) respectfully seeks a 30-day extension of STA previously granted to Maris to add ICEYE’s space stations licensed under Call Sign S00757¹ as an additional point of communication to its fixed earth station located in Boardman, Oregon (the “Boardman Earth Station”; Call Sign E181611).² The grant for Call Sign S00757 lists the Boardman Earth Station as a point of communication.³

Grant of this STA is in the public interest because it will enable Maris to continue to support ICEYE in accordance with its mission objectives.

Consistent with Section 1.62 of the Federal Communications Commission’s rules,⁴ Maris will continue communicating with the ICEYE satellites licensed under Call Sign S00757 pursuant to the terms and conditions of its expiring STA pending grant of the instant extension request.⁵
