Re: Request for Special Temporary Authority to Operate a Remote VSAT Terminal with Intelsat's Ellenwood, Georgia VSAT Hub, Call Sign E990433

Intelsat License LLC, as debtor in possession ("Intelsat"), herein requests Special Temporary Authority ("STA")¹ for 30 days, commencing November 10, 2020, to temporarily operate a 1.2 m Skyware VSAT terminal with Intelsat's Ellenwood, Georgia VSAT hub, Call Sign E990433,² in order to communicate with Galaxy 18³ (S2733) for a customer demonstration. The VSAT terminal will be located in Redmond, Washington and the proposed demonstration is expected to take approximately four months.

The proposed operations will be conducted in the following frequency bands: 11700-12200 MHz and 14000-14500 MHz. The 24x7 contact information for the Galaxy 18 operations is as follows:

All proposed operations will be consistent with Intelsat's coordination agreements for Galaxy 18. In the extremely unlikely event that harmful interference should occur due to transmissions to or from its remote terminal, Intelsat will take all reasonable steps to eliminate the interference.
