The SAPA 12.8M antennas to be used for these communications (one as primary and the other as the back-up) are authorized per COMSAT's KB34 (the primary) and KA31 (the back-up) licenses to communicate in the L-band and C-band with ISAT list satellites generally as well as specifically named Inmarsat satellites within the view of the Santa Paula teleport.
