Nextel Communications, Inc. ("Nextel") and Sprint Corporation ("Sprint") jointly filed Transfer of Control of Licenses and Authorizations on February 8, 2005.¹ The Satellite Earth Station applications referenced below were among multiple applications filed seeking Commission approval for the transfer of control to Sprint of the approximately 40,000 licenses and authorizations held both directly and indirectly by Nextel.
