Global Crossing Americas Solutions, Inc. ("GCAS") hereby seeks consent to the *pro forma* transfer of control of GCAS's non-common carrier earth station authorizations from Impsat Fiber Networks, Inc. ("IFN") to ALC Communications Corp. ("ALC"). This *pro forma* transfer of control is part of an internal corporate restructuring, by which ALC, through a series of steps, will acquire the stock of GCAS from IFN, such that GCAS will become a direct subsidiary of ALC. For important business reasons, it is critical that this *pro forma* transaction close by September 30, 2010. Accordingly, GCAS respectfully requests that the Commission process this application on an expedited basis.

GCAS, IFN, and ALC are all indirect, U.S. subsidiaries of Temasek Holdings (Private) Limited ("Temasek"). Because Temasek thus will continue to have ultimate control of GCAS's licenses, the transfer of control to ALC is considered *pro forma* under the Commission's rules. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 63.24(d) ("[A]ssignments that do not result in a change in the actual controlling party are considered non-substantial or *pro forma*."); *id.*, Note 2 (stating that a "an assignment from a corporation to a corporation owned or controlled by the assignor stockholders without substantial change in their interests" is presumptively *pro forma*). In addition, no services will be discontinued as a result of this *pro forma* transfer of control. Accordingly, approval of this *pro forma* transfer of control would be in the public interest.

that, because "section 310(b)(4) governs only common carrier, broadcast, and aeronautical en

route or fixed radio licenses," the Commission would "not consider here the proposed foreign

ownership as it relates to the non-common carrier earth station license").
