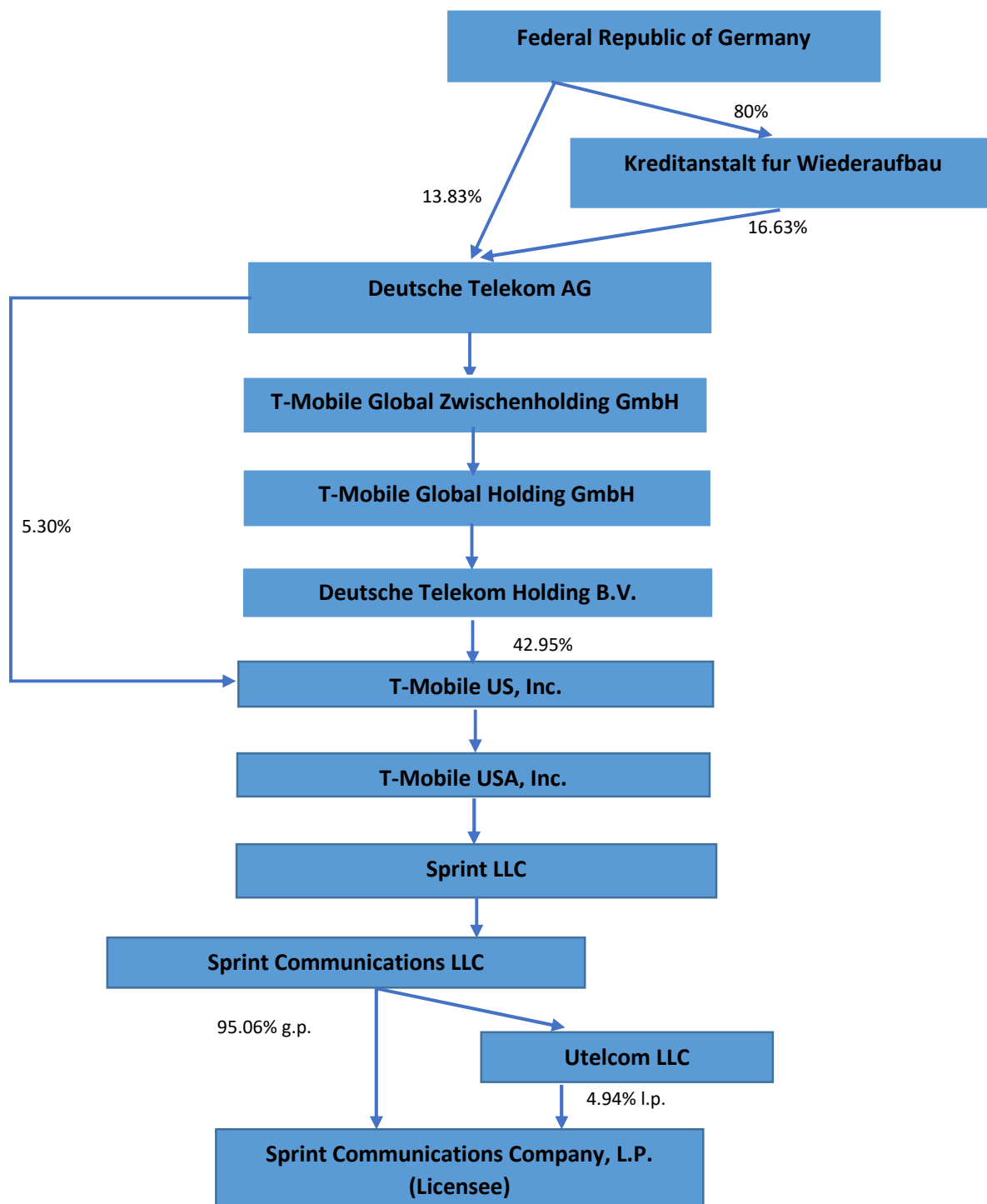


Description of Transaction

Sprint Communications Company, L.P. (“Licensee”) is an indirect, wholly owned subsidiary of T-Mobile US, Inc. (“T-Mobile”). Deutsche Telekom AG (“DT”) currently directly and indirectly owns approximately 48.3% of T-Mobile’s shares in the aggregate, but also has *de facto* control of T-Mobile – and thus Licensee – as a result of proxy agreements which authorize DT to vote a majority of the shares of T-Mobile. DT and T-Mobile anticipate that DT’s shareholdings in T-Mobile, held directly and through various subsidiaries of DT, will increase to 50% or more in the near future. Accordingly, pursuant to Section 25.119(h) of the Commission’s rules, 47 C.F.R. § 25.119(h), this filing requests Commission approval for DT to acquire *de jure* control of the earth station authorizations¹ held by Licensee when that increase in DT’s shareholdings occurs. No other change in Licensee’s ownership is contemplated. Attached are charts showing the ownership of Licensee before and after the transaction.

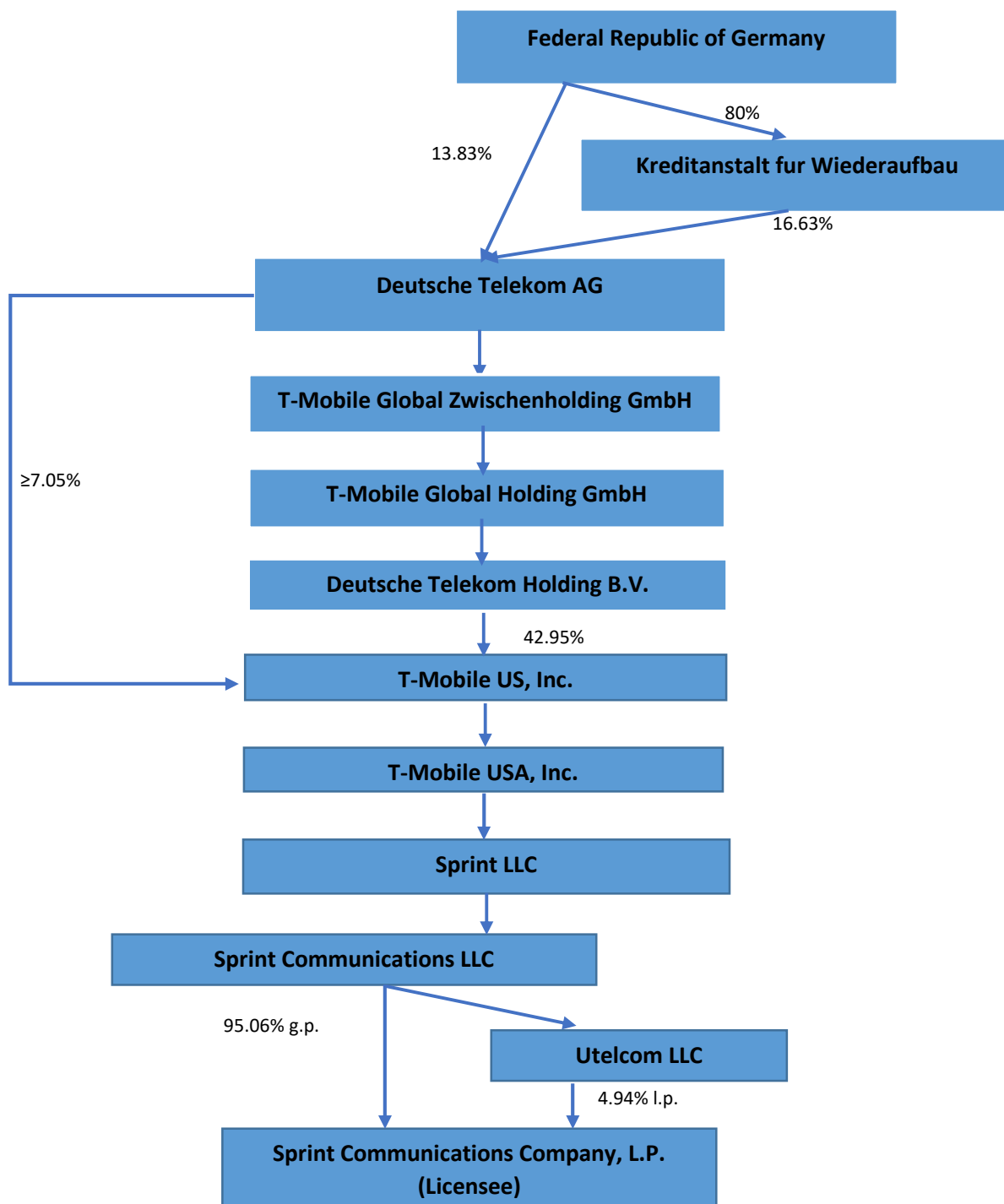
¹ Applications for Commission approval of the *pro forma* transfer of control of other licenses and spectrum leases not subject to forbearance and held by Licensee and other subsidiaries of T-Mobile are being filed with the Commission contemporaneously. These entities also hold FCC licenses and spectrum leases that are subject to forbearance. Notifications for the *pro forma* transfer of these licenses and leases will be submitted post-closing.
