Public Interest Statement

Pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 310(d) and 47 C.F.R. § 25.119 of the Federal Communications Commission’s (“Commission’s”) rules, The Switch Enterprises, LLC (“The Switch” or “Transferor”) and Tata Communications (Netherlands) B.V. (“Tata Communications” or “Transferee”) hereby seek Commission consent for the proposed transfer of control of The Switch to Tata Communications. The Switch holds a license for a single Ku-band transmit/receive earth station located in Burbank, California (Los Angeles County) used to support the provision of live video production and distribution for The Switch’s enterprise U.S. customers.¹ The Switch does not provide telecommunications services (*i.e.*, common carrier services). Tata Communications will acquire a 100% equity stake in The Switch through a membership interest purchase agreement dated December 22, 2022 (the “Purchase Agreement”).

The Switch is a market-leading live production and transmission service provider in the United States, with customers ranging from tech giants to major global broadcasters and premier sports organizations. The Switch’s production platform enables its customers to cost-effectively capture, edit, package, and deliver compelling live coverage. The Switch is able to seamlessly link rights holders, broadcasters, streaming platforms, media outlets and web services – and turn on live content, throughout the United States and beyond. The Switch is trusted by its customers to format and deliver their content across linear TV, on-demand, and streaming platforms, to ensure premium viewing experiences.

With The Switch and Tata Communications coming together, The Switch will be able to accelerate its efforts to provide stability, greater investment, and vision to further its services to United States customers. The Switch continues to innovate to stay ahead as the media industry evolves, and The Switch sees the opportunity as a result of the transaction with Tata Communications to play an ever-larger role in the future of live sports and entertainment as it enables customers to maximize their content. The Switch anticipates leveraging Tata Communications’ global resources to better help media owners and enterprises harness emerging digital consumption patterns to drive innovation and dynamic growth, all while maintaining the same high level of service for which The Switch has been known. In particular, The Switch will continue to use the earth station referenced herein, in the same manner and for the same purposes as before the transaction. Accordingly, consent to the above-referenced transfer of control would strongly support the public interest.
