Each of these satellites listed above is on the Commission’s Permitted List. Pursuant to the DISCO II First Reconsideration Order, FCC 99-325 (released October 29, 1999), a U.S.-licensed earth station with an ALSAT license is permitted to access any space station on the Permitted List, provided that the space station complies with the Commission's technical requirements, and operates under the conditions on its license and set forth in the Orders cited at <https://www.fcc.gov/permitted-space-station-list>.
