On behalf of Satamatics, Inc. (f/k/a Richtec Incorporated) ("Satamatics"), this letter is being submitted in order to surrender the International Section 214 authorization File No. ITC-214-20020228-00160 currently held by Satamatics.

On January 29, 2008, the International Bureau granted a request by Satamatics to change the regulatory status of the company's blanket Inmarsat D+ terminal authorization from common carrier to non-common carrier. *See* File No. SES-MOD-20070924-01315. Accordingly, Satamatics currently offers the Inmarsat D+ services on a non-common carrier basis and no longer needs an International Section 214 authorization. The surrender of this International Section 214 authorization will not result in any impairment or discontinuance of service to the customers of Satamatics because it will continue to provide services to its customers on a non-common carrier basis.
