Intelsat License LLC, as debtor in possession ("Intelsat"), herein relinquishes the E190237 receive-only registration, effective immediately. Per the International Bureau's instruction, Intelsat timely registered the C-band antenna on behalf of one of Intelsat's United States Federal Government customers in 2018. The customer recently informed Intelsat that the registered antenna will no longer be used. To the extent necessary, Intelsat requests that the Federal Communications Commission ("Commission") cancel the registration and remove the antenna from the Commission's C-band incumbent earth station list.¹
