
Dear Ms. Dortch:

Michaelsen Communications, LLC (“Michaelsen Communications”), licensee of receive-only earth station E180894 (“E180894”), hereby notifies the Commission that E180894 will not be transitioning to the upper 200 MHz of the 3.7-4.2 GHz band (C-Band). Michaelsen Communications last used the facilities operated under E180894’s license on October 31, 2020, and has determined that it will discontinue operations under E180894’s license on a permanent basis. Accordingly, Michaelsen Communications is also surrendering E180894’s authorization via the Commission’s myIBFS database simultaneously with this letter.

Michaelsen Communications understands that its discontinuance of operations under E180894’s license will not nullify its eligibility to receive a lump sum reimbursement as a result of the C-Band transition. Michaelsen Communications’ lump sum reimbursement eligibility was established in E180894’s lump sum election form, which was timely filed in this Docket. *See* Michaelsen Communications, LLC, Lump Sum Payment Election for C-Band Receive-Only Earth Station (E180894), IB Docket No. 20-205 (filed Sept. 11, 2020), *erratum* filed Oct. 28, 2020.
