NOTICE OF SURRENDER OF RECEIVE-ONLY EARTH STATION REGISTRATION

Pursuant to the International Bureau’s September 27, 2021 Public Notice,¹ Graham Media Group, Inc. (“Graham”), on behalf of its operating subsidiary Graham Media Group, San Antonio, Inc., hereby surrenders the following receive-only earth station registration:

The single 4.5-meter antenna included in the E050030 registration receives in the Ku-band—not the C-band—and will continue to do so following the surrender of the E050030 registration. Because the Federal Communications Commission “does not license or register receive-only FSS stations operating in the 11.7–12.2 GHz frequency band,”³ Graham understands that no further action is necessary for its 4.5-meter antenna to continue operating on a receive-only basis without interference following the surrender of the E050030 registration.
